Q: What events will submissions be considered for?

A: The VMUG 2023 Call for Content will be accepting submissions for Virtual and In-person events such as UserCons, as well as for webcast opportunities, blog posts, podcasts and Video opportunities (I.e., VMUGTV). The VMUG 2023 Call for Content portal will be open all year for opportunities to partner with VMUG for available opportunities.

Q: What if I submitted a session for 2022 that I want used in 2023? Do I need to resubmit?

A: If you submitted a session in 2022 and would like to resubmit it for 2023, you will need to go through the submission process again to resubmit that session for consideration in the new calendar year.

Q: I am trying to login to the submission website using my VMUG website login, but it is not working. How do I submit a proposal?

A: Each submitter will need to create a new username and password to submit in the Call for Content. You may do this by clicking on "First-time user" on the submissions home page. If you submitted through the 2020-2022 Call for Content, please use the username and password you already established. If you are unsure what your login may be, please click reset password or email content@vmug.com so that the team can help you get into your account.

Q: What does each type of submission opportunity involve?

- UserCons An in-person event and will require a 30 45-minute presentation that can include Q&A for the audience.
 - Virtual Events An event that will take place virtually on the vFairs platform
 - Simulive with Q&A Your session will need to be pre-recorded and you will be expected to participate at the time your session is airing for Live Q&A with the audience.
 - On-Demand Your session will need to be pre-recorded and will be available all day for attendees to view.
 - Blogs & Podcasts If selected for blog and podcasts, the VMUG content team will reach out with details regarding timing.
 - Webinars If selected for webinars, the VMUG content team will reach out with details regarding timing

VMUG 2022 Call for Content FAQ (cont.)

Q: How are submissions selected?

A: A first-level review by VMUG Leaders occurs for all submissions. The VMUG Leaders will review based off submission characteristics such as topic, description, relevancy, timing, meeting content goals, etc.

Once the first-level review is completed, all submissions will go through a second-level review by the Content Review Task Force. We will use these reviews to help slot our H1 events and you will be notified if your submission has been accepted. We are tasked with creating a program filled with content that will be compelling, interesting, fresh, and actionable for attendees for VMUG events and opportunities. We look for innovative formats, complete submissions, and unique perspectives.

If you are a selected Community Speaker, VMUG will cover all travel expenses.

Q: How can I increase my odds of being selected?

A: Each year we receive more submissions than we need for our events. While there are some repeat presenters (only top rated), we do seek to ensure most of our speakers and presentations are brand new for each event. Submission content should be well-thought out, complete, and unique. Tell your story – have you gone through an upgrade recently? What was your experience? Have a case study you want to share? We want to hear about it! Do not shy away from a lively discussion – this is a forum for industry collaboration, and debates and out-of-the-box thinking are appreciated. Challenge the audience with unconventional thinking.

Q: Can I submit a session on behalf of someone else?

A: Yes. Within the submission form is a section to add other speakers. You can identify the primary presenter + any alternative speakers that may be able to present that session.

Q: Can my submission be revised after it has already been submitted?

A: Yes, proposals may be revised at any time up until the submission deadline. A confirmation email will be sent upon submission, giving the submitter the password-protected URL for the proposal.

Q: What are the 3 Topic Focus' for 2023 Content Submissions?

A: • Core:

For vSphere or Horizon users, these sessions will help provide the tools to upgrade their current platform and get the most out of their vSphere or Horizon environment.

• Emerging:

For members who have an upgraded skillset or company technology such as vSAN / HCI, NSX, Workspace ONE or VMware Cloud Foundation. These sessions would help provide a deeper understanding in VMware's emerging technologies.

• Future:

For members who have fully adopted the newest technology within the Public Cloud or DevOps space or are interested in learning what's coming in the future such as Kubernetes, Tanzu and Carbon Black Cloud.
